Since its' inauguration in July 2017, Riviera Lifeline has provided support and assistance to more than 40 seniors in the Alpes Maritimes and the Var, donating in excess of €45.000 in financial grants, services and equipment.

A team of devoted volunteers is engaged every week in visiting people in their own homes, offering companionship and helping them to feel secure and valued members of the community. We are working closely with Pro Seniors, a company that provides professional services in areas such as domestic cleaning, shopping, meals service and dealing with French administration.

In the autumn, Riviera Lifeline began an initiative to provide Soup and Cheese lunches at The Grange in Mouans-Sartoux on Thursdays and, such was the popularity, that we have continued this service throughout the year, catering for up to forty people at times.

All those whose services are indispensable in allowing us to carry out our work are volunteers, giving their time freely, and we are urgently in need of extra hands, whether visiting seniors or helping with the catering. If you have a few hours to spare, we would be delighted to hear from you and to discuss how your interests and skills could contribute to our mission.
